



WELCOME TO PATAGONIA

Want to venture further into South America during your travels? Now you can, with a 4-day Journey extension to **Patagonia, Argentina!** Following the completion of your Journey, instead of boarding a flight to return to the US, you will catch a plane headed for El Calafate, where you will enjoy 3 nights and 4 days, taking in some of the most impressive vistas of Patagonia's jagged peaks, pristine rivers and dusty backwater oases. Tour the Earth's most dynamic and accessible ice fields at Los Glaciares National Park where you will visit Perito Moreno Glacier, the stunning centerpiece of the southern sector of the park. Creeping forward at up to 6.5 feet per day, you will be able to closely anticipate when building-sized icebergs begin to loosen and calve from its face. Afterwards, sail through the North Arm of Lake Argentino. Fed by the glacial meltwater of several rivers, you will find a spectacular iceberg barrier. You will get up close and personal with the awe-inspiring, highest glacier in the national park; the Spegazzini Glacier. Your once-in-a-lifetime experience awaits!

DAY 1

Your Journey extension begins as you arrive in Buenos Aires and fly to El Calafate. You will be welcomed by your local host at the El Calafate Airport where you will then transfer to your hotel to check in and relax.

Finish the night with included dinner at your hotel, including one glass of wine and one soft drink.

DAY 2

Begin your morning with breakfast at the hotel before starting a day of touring **Perito Moreno Glacier** and **Los Glaciares National Park**.

The **Perito Moreno Glacier** is the stunning centerpiece of the southern sector of **Los Glaciares National Park**. Locally referred to as Glaciar Moreno, it measures over 18 miles long, over 3 miles wide, and almost 200 feet high. This is one of the largest glaciers in the world. What makes it exceptional, as well as the biggest attraction at Los Glaciares National Park, is its constant advance—up to 6.5 feet per day, causing building-sized icebergs to calve from its face and create a great thunder as they crash into the deep waters of the Argentino Lake.

Head back to the hotel to relax over an included dinner with a glass of wine and soft drink.

DAY 3

Start day 3 with breakfast at the hotel before transferring to the boat and boarding your glacier-viewing cruise. Set sail through the north arm of **Lake Argentino** until reaching the Upsala Channel, where you will encounter a spectacular iceberg barrier. Enjoy an included box lunch onboard the boat as you navigate the Spegazzini Channel. Observe the Seco Glacier to reach the front of the **Spegazzini Glacier**, the highest in the National Park. Return to Punta Bandera Port where your host will be waiting to transfer you back to your hotel.


